1. Purpose

- To promote community activism and practice by supporting project ideas related to safety, health, and environment.
- Help with community activities by grassroots NGOs and people in nations that are targets of support

2. Overview

- **Areas** : Community projects that aim to find a solution to and tackle the issue in following areas OR aims to develop and enhance the capacity of groups working on the following areas:
 - 1) Clean air and water
 - 2) Promoting sustainable agriculture and food security
 - 3) Life on land and below water
 - 4) Affordable and clean energy
 - 5) Responsible consumption and production
 - 6) Sustainable habitats and communities
 - 7) Climate adaptation and action
 - 8) Environmental education and environmental justice
 - 9) Industrial safety and occupational health
- **Scope of the project** : The grant will fund projects that are related to safety, health, and environment, which can take form of campaigns, workshops, training program, content production, etc.
- **Eligibility**
 - 1) **Grassroots groups registered** with the governments of countries in the OECD DAC (Development Assistance Committee) list of ODA Recipients on 2020
 - 2) **Groups that consist 5 or more people**

(Needs to submit a letter of recommendation from a group that is officially registered from its government)

※ Overseas branches of organization from non-recipient country and INGOs are not applicable. Only citizens themselves or grassroots organizations from OECD ODA recipient countries can apply.

- **Funding** : Each project is funded up to **USD \$3,000, to a maximum of 20 projects**
Among the funded projects, teams that show potential for further development will be provided with an additional opportunity for a **site visit mentoring, a visit to Korea and a continuing funding opportunity**

3. Selection process

- Application → Application review by our Committee → Video PT* → Signing agreement and MOU
※ Shortlisted groups must upload their project idea presentation via youtube
- Documents
 - ① Application (Project Proposal, Budget, Consent to Collection and Use of Personal Information)
 - ② An official document that proves registration with the government (e.g. Business registration card/ Group registration card) or A letter of recommendation for that are in 2) of eligibility
- Selection Standards : Projects that show social value, practical applicability, and potential for further development
- Apply : Fill out the application and submit via our **website(www.koreashe.org/board/idea-latest)**
※ Chrome recommended and please check the 'Application Status' at MyPage after submitting your application

5. Second round funding

- A selected number of projects are eligible for a second round funding up to 3 years
- The teams selected for the excellence of their activity ideas will be invited to Korea to participate in the Korea SHE Foundation's future event
- Team members from funded projects will be positively considered for the Foundation's Global Scholarship Program, if they apply (<http://bitly.kr/S10oxQCw>)

6. Note

- Submitted documents will not be returned, so be sure to keep a copy
- If the recipient is found to have submitted fraudulent documents or violated plagiarism, the total amount of funding received will be confiscated
- The project must be completed by the proposed due date, and project report of the outcomes must be submitted after completion. Failure to submit the final report by the deadline will result in your team having to return the total amount of funding, and will be barred from applying to any Korea SHE Foundation opportunities for 5 years.
- Recipients will be disqualified if they show a lack of progress or poor results, which will be evaluated during progress and final evaluations.
